

Notice of Restricted Opening of the Temple for Private Prayers (Individual or Household)

From Monday 15th June 2020

Statement from the Board of Trustees of Shri Venkateswara Balaji Temple of UK

After due consideration of the current situation with the Covid-19 pandemic and the new guidance published by the Government on limited re-opening of the places of worship for individual prayers, we have taken a guarded decision to allow devotees for private prayers, with conditions, as individuals or as individual households to visit the temple with pre-booked appointments only from Monday 15th June.

During this stage of the limited opening, only those individuals or households who book for any rituals, homams, or abishekams will be allowed to attend the temple in strictly limited numbers as a **single-family group or as individuals**.

As our overriding priority is the safety of the devotees, priests, and the staff, and minimising the risk of virus transmission to near zero, we would politely request all devotees who attend the temple during this period to **strictly follow the social distancing guidelines** as recommended by the Government.

Our aim is to allow all the devotees to have darshan as soon as the restrictions are further eased by the Government.

The trustees are grateful to all our devotees and visitors for their understanding and forbearance.

We urge everyone to do their bit to stay safe and follow the Government's guidelines wherever you are.
