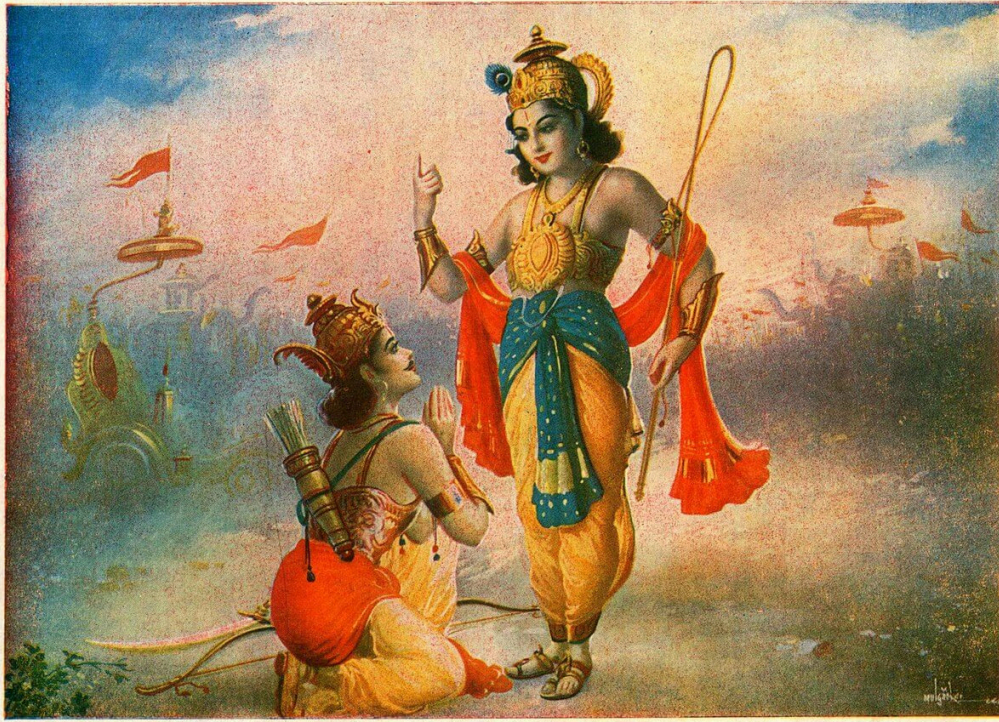


Balaji Summer Youth Camp 2026
